

RULES OF PROPER DISPOSAL OF WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

1.

Leave waste equipment in the shop where you buy a new device.

- every shop has an obligation to take back your old equipment free of charge, if you buy there new equipment of the same kind performing the same function.

2.

Leave small waste electrical and electronic equipment at a large supermarket without having to buy a new one.

- stores with a sales area of equipment designed for households of min. 400 m² are obliged to take back waste equipment from households, whose no external dimension is more than 25 cm, free of charge, at their own location or the one in its immediate vicinity without having to purchase new equipment intended for households.

3.

Leave waste electrical and electronic equipment at the point of delivery.

- distributor, delivering equipment designed for households to the purchaser, is obliged to take back waste equipment from households in the place of delivery of such equipment free of charge, provided that the waste equipment is of the same type and served the same functions as the supplied equipment.

4.

Bring waste equipment to a collection point.

- information on the nearest location can be found on the municipal website or bulletin board of the municipal office as well as on the website www.remondis-elektro.pl.

5.

Leave the equipment at a service point.

- if the repair is unprofitable or impossible for technical reasons, the service centre is obliged to take back such device free of charge.

6.

Equipment thus collected is sent to specialized treatment facilities, where dangerous substances will be removed from it first. Other items will undergo recovery and recycling.

7.

Do not dispose of waste equipment together with other waste. Such conduct is punishable by fines.

8.

Proper disposal of waste equipment helps prevent potential negative consequences for the environment and human health. At the same time it saves natural resources of our Earth by reuse of raw materials recovered from equipment processing.
